PETILLANT NATUREL

Pétillant naturel is the oldest method of making sparkling wine. It is also known as the method ancestral or ancestral method. This winemaking technique involves bottling wine that is still fermenting to trap carbon dioxide gas in the bottle, creating a gentle carbonation. Pet-nat wines (as they are called) are becoming more popular as part of the general trend toward natural wine.

CHARMAT METHOD

The second fermentation takes place in a pressurized tank, rather than in a bottle, decreasing lees contact and producing larger, coarser bubbles. The wine is filtered under pressure and bottled. Also known as the bulk process or tank method. Expect light, less complex flavours.

TRADITIONAL METHOD

A labor-intensive process where secondary fermentation happens in the bottle, creating fine bubbles. It gives rich, creamy texture and notes of toast and bread dough, typical of Champagne and other high-quality sparkling wines.

Franciacorta DOCG

Italy’s finest sparkling wine, Franciacorta comes from a DOCG area in Lombardia, nestled between Brescia and the southern shore of Lake Iseo. It’s known for high-quality, traditional method sparkling wines.

CARIGNANO
